## **Internship Rotations**

This internship includes a major rotation (40 hours weekly). This internship is ideal for someone with varying psychology interests and someone also interested in the medical field. Interns with the ability to quickly change gears and have an ease to work with all ages are particularly suitable.

### Medical Psychology (Major Rotation)

The intern will provide psychological services to a range of patients including children, adolescents, adults and seniors. Interns will be working in both outpatient and inpatient settings. Therapy will be a component of this internship, providing therapeutic services to couples, children, individuals and families. Diverse mental health and medical conditions are common with many of the populations that will be presented.

## **General Experience Information**

AllCare is a family-owned organization providing primary healthcare to patients of all ages, from newborn to aging adults. A psychological component is integrated throughout the primary healthcare practice, concentrating on the necessity to concurrently treat both the mind and the body.

- Interns will provide psychological services, including individual and family therapy, to an outpatient population including children, adolescents, adults and geriatrics that present with acute mental health issues.
- Interns will have the opportunity to provide neuropsychological assessments to patients that present with medical, psychological and neuropsychological conditions.
- Interns will provide comprehensive psychological assessments to children, adolescents and adults for diagnostic clarity and treatment planning.
- Interns will be providing these services in office, skilled nursing and hospital settings.

## **Didactics and Supervision**

#### **Didactics**

Centerstone Consortium offers over 100 hours of didactic training in a variety of areas. Major training topics include: neurological issues in child assessment, co-occurring disorders, trauma-informed practice, integration with other disciplines/primary care and professional development as a psychologist.

Each year, the training interests of the interns are taken into account in providing specialty clinical training. Per the request of our interns, online trainings have also been incorporated into our curriculum. However, formal, didactic face-to-face contact for interns also occurs regularly.

### **Supervision**

Supervision is always provided by a licensed psychologist associated with that rotation. For 2020-2021, Dr. Matthew Nessetti, Ph.D., will be providing the supervision for the internship.

Centerstone uses the Online APPIC Application Materials. In addition, this location requires an integrative psychological assessment.

Completed packets for 2020-2021 must be submitted no later than November 1, 2019. Incomplete packets will not be reviewed.
