CASTLE services include:

- Comprehensive assessment of the child's current skills and deficits (including language and behavioral) conducted by a Board-Certified Behavioral Analyst (BCBA)
- Individualized treatment plan
- Development of age-appropriate academic and daily living skills
- Improvement of social skills and language
- Reduction in behavior challenges
- Verbal behavior training
- Ongoing support and training for parents and caregivers
- Engagement in daily living activities
