# Group Homes:

Krause Street, Main Street and State Street



Centerstone's group homes serve adults ages 22 and above who have a serious mental health condition, such as depression, schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, or schizoaffective disorder. While living at the group homes, residents participate in counseling and life skills training to prepare them for living successful, independent lives.

#### Residents will also:

- Improve daily living skills
- Develop conflict resolution skills
- Learn about money management
- Receive medication education
- Identify and build social supports
- Learn self advocacy skills
- Have medical concerns addressed by trained staff members

**Homes are located in Alton and Jerseyville, Illinois.** During the first 30 days of residency, new residents will be accompanied by at staff member at all times to ensure a smooth transition. After 90 days, residents are encouraged to engage in community based activities independently.

Group home residents must have Illinois Medicaid or have selected one of the Managed Medicaid providers for Illinois such as Meridian or Molina or either SSI or SSDI.
