



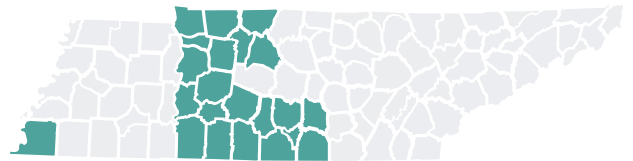

Expanding support for those who contact the 988 Suicide and Crisis Lifeline

Centerstone provides crisis support and resources throughout Tennessee, including the operation of the 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline center. Our 988 crisis center team is staffed with highly-trained and compassionate professionals who are available via phone, text, and chat 24/7/365 to help anyone experiencing a mental health crisis in these Tennessee counties: Bedford, Cheatham, Coffee, Davidson, Dickson, Franklin, Giles, Hickman, Houston, Humphreys, Lawrence, Lewis, Lincoln, Marshall, Maury, Montgomery, Moore, Perry Robertson, Shelby, Stewart, and Wayne.



When someone in crisis contacts the 988 Lifeline, Centerstone addresses their immediate need and asks for their consent to allow us to contact them within 24 hours. These follow-up specialists will connect the person with mental health care and social determinant resources, such as food, housing, and employment.



Through experience and research, Centerstone has learned that outcomes are improved when referrals to services are made swiftly and barriers to access are eliminated. It's impossible for one organization to meet all of an individual's needs, which is why Centerstone recognizes the importance of collaboration and partnership. When like-minded community organizations come together, we can create a more comprehensive, whole-person approach to care. We can close gaps in services and provide a bridge through our coordinated efforts that offers sustainable solutions for those in our community who need it most. By reaching out to you, our hope is to develop a mutually beneficial relationship that improves outcomes for those experiencing crisis and expands quality care for people in our communities who have significant need.
