# The following in-home services are available through Centerstone's Healthier Beginnings:

# Parent Coaching (Growing Great Kids & Pyramid Model):

All parents and guardians will learn the Pyramid Model and activities that boost baby's brain development and strengthen the child/parent relationship to help children succeed in school and improve social skills.

#### Prenatal and Postpartum Support:

- Prenatal and postnatal depression screening
- Breastfeeding support

#### Stress Management:

• Receive support and engage in activities for healthy coping during times of stress.

#### **Integrated Health and Wellness:**

- Tobacco Free Program: A program designed to help expecting parents and parents/guardians quit smoking while earning free diapers and parent child health incentives.
- Developmental screenings
- Family and health education

#### Resource Linkage:

- Connecting families and caregivers to community resources
- Providing parents and caregivers with information about support groups
- Addiction related services, support, and connection

### **Eligibility:**

If you live in the following counties: Cannon, Coffee, Dickson, Giles, Hickman, Humphreys, Lawrence, Lewis, Maury, Perry, Rutherford, Van Buren, Warren, Wayne, and Williamson, and are pregnant or have a child up to 24 months of age, please contact Centerstone's Healthier Beginnings by phone at (931) 490-1580.

## **Child Welfare Protocols:**

A family with a child up to 24 months of age may be enrolled in the voluntary services if referred by the Tennessee Department of Children Services or Safe Baby Court. Services will be offered up to the time the child is five years of age

Healthier Beginnings, funded by four grants from the Tennessee Department of Health, uses the Healthy Families America evidence-based home visiting model to provide these services in the counties listed above.
