Florida Impact Report

Centerstone is a nonprofit health system providing mental health and substance use disorder treatments. Services are available nationally through the operation of outpatient clinics, residential programs, the use of telehealth, and an inpatient hospital.

Accomplishments

- Awarded two \$4 million Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) grants which total \$8 million in funding over two years, helping Centerstone provide greater access to services for people of all ages in underserved communities in Lee and Manatee counties.
- Expanded the delivery of clinical mental health and addiction services in DeSoto and Lee counties, resulting in Centerstone's first outpatient office in DeSoto County and its second location in Lee County.
- Hosted the 21st Annual Life;Story 5k/10k Walk and Run for suicide prevention. More than 750 attended and more than \$159,000 was raised for suicide awareness and prevention.
- Started the FLIGHT Program for adults with substance use disorder who are at risk of losing parental rights in Charlotte and Collier counties. A coordinated effort between the judicial system and Centerstone, FLIGHT supports a family's complex needs by providing case management, peer services, and therapy services.
- Served 62 patients through the new CORE program in Manatee County, which provides peer support and medication-assisted treatment (MAT) services for those experiencing overdose. This is a collaboration between Central Florida Behavioral Health Network, Manatee County Emergency Management Services, Florida Department of Health, MCR Health, and Centerstone.
- Centerstone's Children's Community Action Treatment Team (CAT) served 535 families in Lee, Hendry, Glades, Manatee, Sarasota, and DeSoto counties this year. This multi-disciplinary clinical team provides comprehensive, intensive community-based treatment to families with youth and young adults, ages 0-21, who are at risk of out-of-home placement due to a mental health or co-occurring disorder and related complex issues for whom traditional services are not/have not been adequate.
- Hosted three crisis intervention trainings with 107 first responders from Manatee county Sherriff's Department, EMTs, and 911 call center staff, and from the Bradenton and Palmetto Police Departments.
- Received a \$100,000 donation from Hugh Culverhouse, Jr. and a \$50,000 from Gulf Coast Community Foundation, both supporting the Comprehensive Treatment Court (CTC) program in Sarasota. CTC is a program operated within the local courts that helps individuals experiencing mental health issues and who commit non-violent offenses move out of the jails and into treatment programs that better support their recovery.

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Highlights

Located on a 16-acre park-like setting, Centerstone's Behavioral Health Hospital and Addiction Center includes a 24/7 crisis center, psychiatric hospital, and residential treatment programs for people experiencing addiction and/or mental health concerns. We provide crisis stabilization, comprehensive assessment, medication management, case management, and therapy for families, individuals, and groups in a safe, supportive environment.

Our youth crisis stabilization services are designed to help children and adolescents ages 4 – 17 who are experiencing acute distress from mental illness, social stressors, and/or substance use. Centerstone's adult services include safe, supportive crisis stabilization, psychiatric services, detox, and residential and rehab treatment options.

Centerstone's Behavioral Health Hospital is home to the Centerstone Psychiatry Residency Program and the Centerstone Doctoral Internship in Psychology, both of which provide advanced training opportunities for emerging behavioral health professionals. Now in its ninth year, the Psychiatry Residency Program has graduated more than 17 psychiatrists many of whom have gone on to serve as leaders in behavioral health care.
