Foundation Impact Report

Accomplishments

- Secured \$10,302,158 new revenue in fiscal year 2024 to support patient care.
- Hosted six fundraiser events in fiscal year 2024. Combined, these events raised \$531,283 to support patient care and services, care for members of our military community, and suicide prevention and awareness. In addition, this year's Reclaiming Lives Luncheon was the highest grossing Centerstone event to date, raising more than \$290,000.
- Engaged with private funders who invested almost \$2 million into key initiatives which included our Comprehensive Treatment Court, crisis services, Stride Centers, child and family services, school-based services, workforce development, life skills development, interpreter services, and direct care for our military and veteran community.
- Engaged 672 new donors who joined Centerstone to support our mission of life-saving care.
- Centerstone's Boards of Directors invested more than \$1.1 million through their own giving.
- Through staff engagement, Centerstone colleagues generously donated more than \$200,000, in addition to volunteering hundreds of hours and serving as advocates in our communities.
- Key Partners Awarded:
 - Awarded \$50,000 from Aetna to expand behavioral health access and decrease staff burnout.
 - Awarded \$75,000 from Boeing Global Engagement to support care delivery for the military and veteran community in our Cohen Clinic in Jacksonville, Florida.
 - Awarded \$20,000 by Illinois Children's Healthcare Foundation as one of 20 organizations to receive a grant for workforce development.
 - Awarded \$400,000 from Indiana University Health Foundation to support our Bloomington, Indiana Stride Center.
 - Awarded \$431,000 from USAA to support Military Services; Centerstone will serve as a member of the coalition to prevent veteran suicide.
- Centerstone is honored to partner with multiple Community Foundations across our regions - each with a deep commitment to serve people and our communities.
- Welcomed our first Major Gifts Officer, Lisa Spelta. She will focus on major donor engagement and developing relationships with additional funders.
