



Centerstone offers permanent housing for adults with serious mental health conditions in Carbondale, IL. There are efficiency units (studios) for one person and two-bedroom units for two adults or a family of four. Rents are assisted by the Illinois Housing Development Authority and each resident pays no more than one-third of their income as rent.

There are income limit requirements for the apartments. Units are targeted for households earning at or below 15% or 30% of the Area Median Income. Head of household must have a disability or illness, including but not limited to a physical, developmental or mental limitation, substance use disorder, HIV/AIDS, or is homeless or at risk of homelessness. Applicant disability status, income, and criminal background will be checked when a full application is completed.
