Parenting preschoolers isn't always easy. When behavioral issues become serious or prolonged, Centerstone Early Childhood Services can help. The Regional Intervention Program (RIP) is a parent-implemented, professionally-supported program for young children and their families who are experiencing challenging behaviors. Since 1969 this unique, internationally-recognized program has guided parents in learning the skills to work with their own children while they receive training and support from experienced RIP families.

We can help with the following areas of challenging behavior:

- Tantrums, screaming
- Aggression, destructive behavior
- Hyperactivity, not paying attention
- Trouble with potty training
- Not following directions, stubbornness
- Withdrawn behavior
- Bedtime or sleeping problems

Our Services

Centerstone's RIP is designed to meet the specific needs of each family we serve. Families practice learned skills through sessions in our office then apply them at home, school and other community settings. These services are available in Maury and Montgomery Counties.

Family services include:

- Training in positive behavior management skills through parent and child sessions
- Specialized classrooms where children learn social skills needed for successful school adjustment, peer interaction and performance
- Consultation with the child's teachers to assist with positive behavior changes
- Individualized behavior plans that promote success in community settings

Eligibility

The Regional Intervention Program is available to children ages 1 to 5 and their families. If you are the parent or caregiver of a young child and have concerns about inappropriate or problematic behavior, you may qualify for these free services.

What to Expect

Parents and children will be expected to attend two classes each week until family goals are met. At least one enrolled parent must participate with their child.
