Group Homes:

Krause Street, Main Street and State Street



Centerstone's group homes serve adults ages 20 and above who have a serious mental health condition, such as depression, schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, or schizoaffective disorder. While living at the group homes, residents participate in counseling and life skills training to prepare them for living successful, independent lives.

Residents will also:

- Improve daily living skills
- Develop conflict resolution skills
- Learn about money management

- Identify and build social supports
- Learn self advocacy skills
- Have medical concerns addressed by trained staff members

• Receive medication education

Homes are located in Alton and Jerseyville, Illinois. During the first 30 days of residency, new residents will be accompanied by at staff member at all times to ensure a smooth transition. After 90 days, residents are encouraged to engage in community based activities independently.

To qualify for a group home, you must have Illinois Medicaid or Illinois Managed Medicaid and either SSI or SSDI.
